

# Yeasty Beasties

## Hunting kit

### INSTRUCTIONS:

The kit provided at the **Farmer's Market** gives you everything you need to collect samples that will be used to find new species of yeasts!

Yeasts are naturally found on the bark and in the soil around oak trees and in orchards. Use the tubes and bag provided to collect small amounts of any of the following:

1. Oak tree bark (old oaks are best).
2. Soil from around the base of an oak tree.
3. Soil from an orchard.

Write down **WHERE** the sample was collected on the sample return card (GPS coordinates are the **BEST!**).




